AWARDS	Each event 1 st to 3 rd place medals A Cup will be awarded to the boys winning team and separately to the girls winning team. Comen Trophy will be awarded the winning team (1 st in the total points of boys and girls).
COSTS	Each team is responsible for its own travel and lodging expenses

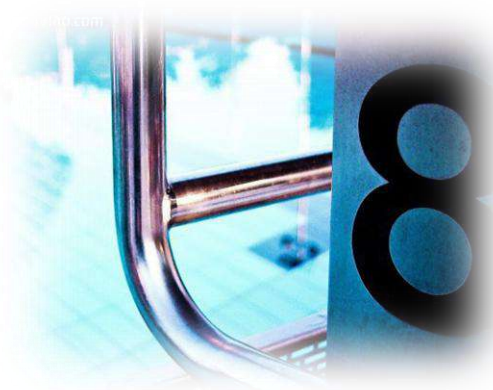
HOST CITY / REGION

Passports, identity cards or certificates of birth of all swimmers, must be presented to the Jury of Appeal for age-check, at the Technical meeting. However, the organizers at their discretion, may also invite non member Federations to participate, against payment of enrolment fee of 10 euro per athlete per entry.

TECHNICAL MEETING

The Technical Meeting will take place at the pool on 20th of June at 17:00 p.m.

Passports, identity cards or certificates of birth of all swimmers, must be presented to the Jury of Appeal for age-check.

OPENING CEREMONY

The opening ceremony shall be held on 21th of June 2019 / 17:00 p.m.

VICTORY CEREMONY

The victory ceremony involve the first, second and third swimmer of each event and will take place after the following event (victory ceremony for one event after the event that follows, etc.)

AWARDS

The first three swimmers of each event shall receive a medal.

A Cup will be awarded to the boys winning team and separately to the girls winning team.

COMEN TROPHY

After the last individual victory ceremony, will be awarded the winning team (1st in the total points of boys and girls).

AWARD OF POINTS

For individual events:

- 1st place 17 points
- 2nd place 15 points
- 3rd place 14 points
- 4th place to 16th place 13 points..1 point For relays:
- The awarded points for relays are as above but multiplied X 2.
- In case of disqualification no points are awarded.
- In case of dead heat in the overall points, the winner shall be decided

according to the number of first places. If a dead heat still remains, the winner shall be decided according to the number of second places, and so on.

PROGRAM

The competition shall be held under FINA-Rules. The starting commands shall be in English.

The competition will be held in 3 (three) days (Friday, Saturday & Sunday) by 21 to 23 June 2019. There will be 15 minutes rest immediately after the end of the last event and before the start of the relay events. Each country may enter 16 boys and 16 girls maximum. Two participants per event and one relay team shall represent each country.

All events shall be held in final heat where the classification shall be decided according to times achieved.

The names and the order of the relay swimmers must be handed before the beginning of each session.
